- Contributed to a number of projects that helped create a unified billing experience between Shopify and Deliverr, which allowed us to host stores on Shopify, but leverage the existing Deliverr billing pipeline.
- Led the "V6 billing project", a cross-disciplinary follow-up to the "V5 billing project" (below); this was an effort to backport the existing billing structure from Deliverr to Shopify, which would ease the future transition to Deliverr's billing pipeline
- Led a series of workshops to help my team learn TypeScript
- At the time of layoffs, I was prototyping a project that would allow us to automatically bill for value-added-services in the warehouse, such as lot tracking. hazardous materials, and delivery duty paid international shipping

- Led a project to retrieve historical pricing data for merchants for use by the operations team in addressing billing disputes
- Took initiative to address sources of significant technical debt
- Contributed to other projects, including those that allowed merchants to ship in their own containers (SIOC), automatically charge merchants for noncompliant inbound shipments, and change how charges are presented to merchants
